Sept. 22–Oct. 20, 2018, GlobalPittsburgh is hosting the Young Leaders of the Americas Initiative (YLAI) Fellowship Program in the greater Pittsburgh area.

The YLAI participants will be placed in a four-week fellowship with a local organization in their field of expertise and develop strategic plans to carry out upon return to their home countries.

About YLAI

The YLAI empowers innovative business and social entrepreneurs from Latin America & the Caribbean to strengthen their capacity to advance their entrepreneurial ideas and effectively contribute to social and economic development in their communities through four-week U.S. fellowships and entrepreneurship training. Pittsburgh has been selected as one of the 20 U.S. host cities.
